Not only has it been hugely popular among diners (the long lines mean you'll need at least 30 minutes to wait), the man behind the store is quite a personality in the ramen scene, as he often appears on TV. What's more, Nantsutteii recently won a ramen competition on a Japanese TV program.

Their signature dish is the Tonkotsu Ma-oil Ramen, which features pork-based creamy soup spiced with a blend of seven types of deep-fried garlic, and sesame oil. Using straight noodle, this combination creates an amazing harmony. Their loyal fans in Tokyo often order a flavoured egg as an extra topping.
